Robert J. Fessler died Saturday at St. Francis Hospital, Marceline.

Fessler reportedly had not been ill prior to early Saturday morning when his wife noticed changes in his breathing pattern. She was unable to awaken him, and Mr. Fessler died later at the hospital.

Services for Mr. Fessler were held this morning in St. Mary of the Angel's church, Wien, under direction of Miller-Tillotson Funeral home. Fr. Patrick Audley officiated and burial was in St. Mary's Cemetery, Wien.

Robert Joseph, son of Edward A. and Theresa Nordman Fessler, was born in Wien, Jan 17, 1917.

On Nov. 17, 1941, he was married to Juanita Marie Clark.

Surviving are his widow of the home; two sons, Robert C., Marceline, Benny Lee, of the home; a daughter, Linda Kay Robinson, Humeston, Iowa; three brothers, Lewis, Macon, Martin, Kansas City, Sylvester, Brookfield; a sister, Mrs. Frances Wehner, New Cambria. He wa preceded in death by his parents.

Mr. Fessler was a veteran of World War II, a member of the Salisbury VFW and St. Mary's Church.

The Rosary was said last night at the Miller-Tillotson Chapel.
