Paul Anthony Meissen, entered his heavenly reward on September 5, 2016. A lifetime farmer of Wien, Missouri, Paul died at Pioneer Health Center in Marceline MO from acute Leukemia. Paul was the son of Helen Catherine (Marek) and Anthony Peter

Meissen, born on January 15, 1934.

Paul spent his entire life on the family farm except for the two years he served in the United States Army from 1956 – 1958. He attended St. Mary of the Angels grade school and graduated from St. Joseph High School in Salisbury, MO. in 1954. He was a member of St. Mary of the Angels Parish Church in Wien where he served on the Parish Board for many years and is fondly remembered for the years he trimmed the hedges along the rectory sidewalk. He was a 3rd Degree member of the St. Pius 12th Knights of Columbus Council #4679 in Salisbury and an avid gardener. As a young adult he played on the local baseball team as a pitcher and played against Hall of Famer Vernon Kennedy.

He is survived by three brothers and three sisters: Elizabeth (Thomas) Stanley, Joseph (Shirley) Meissen, Bernard (Donna) Meissen, Imelda (Wayne) Reigelsberger, Sister Lucy, CPPS and Gregory (Barbara) Meissen. He has 28 nieces and nephews and numerous grand and great grand nieces and nephews.
